

### **EFS Grading Guidelines**

- Grades are recorded in the Genesis System and can be accessed through the Parent Portal. A link can be found on the EFS Website as well as on the EFS APP.
- K-2 Grade Levels and Specials update the system for view at the Mid Trimester mark as well as during the Report Card reporting periods.
- Grades 3-6 update the system periodically throughout the year for access in Genesis as assignments are graded and returned.
- 10 grades per subject area are input for each of the three trimesters. Grades may consist of tests, quizzes, projects, presentations, participation, classwork, group work, online activities, and homework.
- Graded assignments are calculated at varying point values. Parents will be contacted if students earn below 70% on a given assignment, however, those worth smaller point values may not warrant parent contact.
- Online assignments may necessitate accessing Google Classroom or other digital platforms such as Achieve 3000, Newsela, Readworks, Study Island, etc. with your child to review progress.
- Teachers are given a week to input grades following an assessment. (Student absences in the class/grade will delay the process until all missed work is completed and can be reflected in the system consistently.) Long term projects and assignments may necessitate a longer grading period.
- Please consider reaching out to your child's teacher to review his/her progress in class as we want students to focus on the process rather than just the product.
