

Rolling Pickup Information

If you participate in the rolling K-6 pickup line after school, please share the following information with all parties responsible for picking up your child(ren) from school.

Car Line Route:

To arrive at the car line, from Roseland Avenue proceed up Park Lane and bear left at the island following Park Lane around to Essex Road. The car line starts on Essex Road in front of the school gate at your designated grade level times. Pull up to the orange cone as close as possible to give space for the rest of the waiting cars. Do not block any crosswalks or driveways and stay to the right on Essex Road.

Please note:

- Nametags must hang from the rearview mirror until your child(ren) is in the car.
- You will be asked to circle the block if your child(ren) is/are not ready for pickup.
- After your child(ren) is in the car and buckled, you must wait until the car in front of you leave before moving. **DO NOT** drive out of the car line.
- Your child must be able to open/close car doors, buckle themselves, carry backpacks, recognize their car etc, when using the car line.
- Maintain safe and courteous driving at all times.
- Hathaway Lane and Hawthorne Road are both one way during drop-off and pick-up. There is no left turn from Hathaway Lane onto Hawthorne Road at these times.
- If your children require significant assistance to buckle, open doors, get backpacks, etc., please secure a **legal parking space** in the upper lot to allow you to assist them.
- If you park on the roadway, please **DO NOT** allow children to enter or exit your car on the street side of the vehicle. **All children should access cars from the sidewalk side of the car only.**
- Please **ONLY** park in legal parking spaces. Those areas designated as **NO PARKING** are specifically marked as such to ensure the maximum safety of our students. Parking illegally jeopardizes the safety of our children.
- The lower parking lot is reserved for staff members only.
- Please take great caution on the roadways around the school during all arrival and dismissal times.

We would like to make arrival and dismissal times safe and efficient. Pick-up and drop-off traffic can present safety issues. The correct procedures will provide the safest possible environment for all of our children. It is, however, contingent on the cooperation of ALL of our parents/guardians/caregivers.
